### VINEYARD DESCRIPTION:

Chateau Camplazens is located in the Languedoc region of France in the Sub-Appellation of La Clape. La Clape is an environmentally protected mountain overlooking the Mediterranean in which the only permitted activity is grape growing. Since purchasing the vineyard Peter and Susan Close have worked hard to establish Chateau Camplazens as a premium vineyard, with low yields, organic viticulture and modern vinification techniques. Most importantly they want the terrior of La Clape to speak for itself and show the true nature of Chateau Camplazens through its wines.

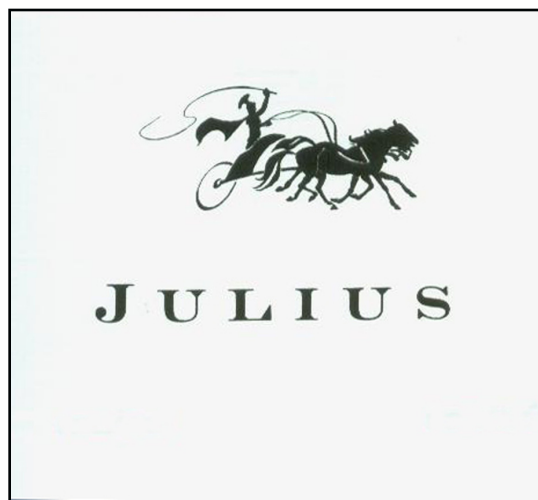
**BLEND:** 100% Syrah from selectively harvested low yield parcels (25 hl/ha)

### TASTING NOTES:

Julius Caesar loved the red wine from the mountain of La Clape, and would demand it be delivered to wherever he was in the vast Roman Empire. To honor our biggest fan we have created « Julius » a small production Syrah blend that embodies all the best we have to offer, just as Caesar would have enjoyed it.

The wine is a pure expression of the varietal that excels in the Languedoc climate and limestone soil. Julius is packed full of minerality, dark forest fruits, pepper,



leather, cassis, and spice. This complex wine is a stunning example of the high quality that the Languedoc is now producing and can be enjoyed now (best decanted) or cellared with confidence for 10+ years.
